# About San Jacinto College

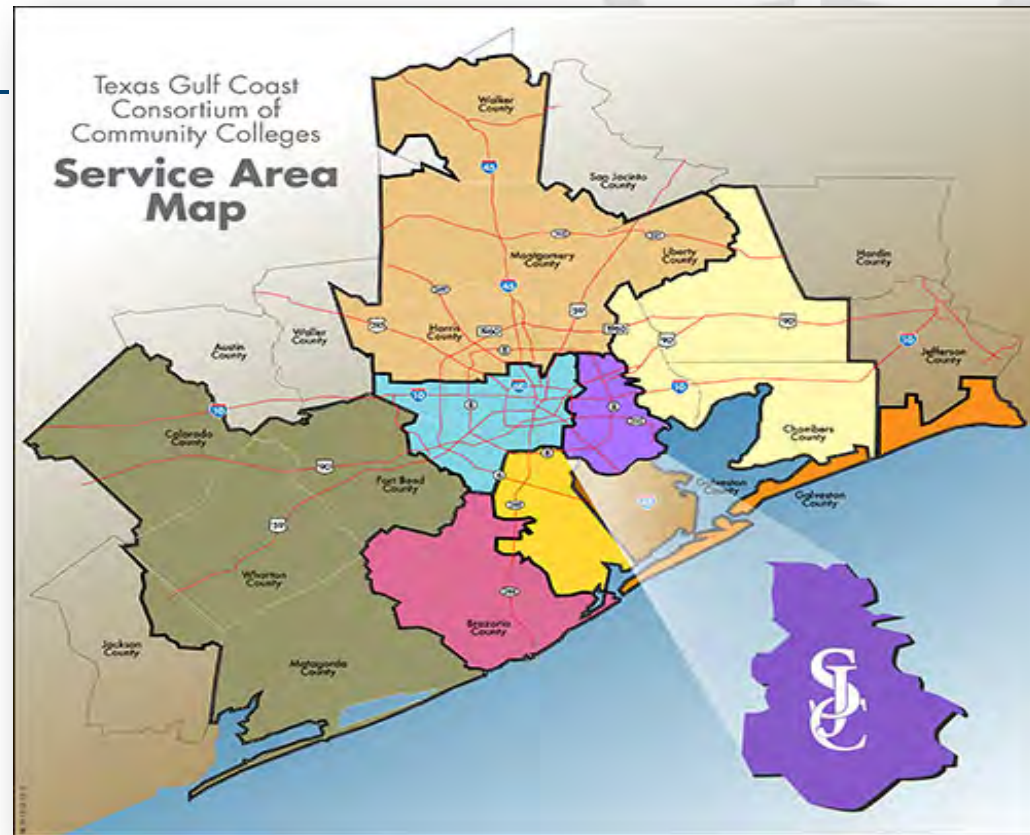

# San Jacinto College Maritime Campus



- 2006: Maritime Forum created to solve the demand for local maritime training in Port Houston
- 2012: Introduced Texas's first every A.A.S. degree in Maritime Transportation
- 2014: Houston Pilots donate 1.3 million Kongsberg simulation suite
- 2016: Moved into 45,000 sq.ft. State-of-the-art Maritime Technology and Training Center
- 2019: Broke ground for onsite fire field
